3. Enclose a headshot or current photo.
4. Enclose a resumé with a description of your performance-related experience and/or training thus far.

6. Two recommendations from teachers, directors or choreographers are required. Please write your name on the top of each Recommendation Form, give to the respondents and have them return the form to CAP21 as soon as possible.
7. Call CAP21 at (212) 807-0202 x 20 to schedule an audition with our Conservatory Coordinator: Ashley Foley. **The application fee, application, picture and resumé must be received by your audition date.***
8. Prepare **32 bars** of an **up-tempo** and a **ballad** and a **one-minute monologue** of your choosing for your audition. Please only use monologues from published full-length plays or screenplays. An accompanist will be provided. Bring the sheet music in the key you will be singing. We encourage you to choose age-appropriate material that you connect to and that shows us who you are. Please feel free to call us if you or your parents have any questions or concerns.

***IF YOU ARE UNABLE TO AUDITION IN PERSON DUE TO THE FACT THAT YOU LIVE OUTSIDE OF THE TRI-STATE AREA (NEW YORK, NEW JERSEY, CONNECTICUT), PLEASE MAKE A VIDEO OR DVD OF YOUR AUDITION FOLLOWING THE INFORMATION IN #8 ABOVE AS WELL AS TELLING US A BIT ABOUT YOURSELF AT THE BEGINNING OF YOUR VIDEO AND INTRODUCING YOUR PIECES BEFORE YOU BEGIN THEM.**
